# I. GENERAL INFORMATION

## I.1 RULES

Age and test qualifications as of 1 March, 2010 (close of entries) will determine classification.

## I.2 ELIGIBILITY

This event is open for participation to all eligible competitors who are members in good standing *with their National Figure Skating Association*. Entries from members of clubs having a probationary status will be accepted provided the entry is accompanied by a signed certification by the skater that (s)he is properly qualified to participate in the events mentioned.

Skaters can enter only one ( 1) compulsory Ice Dance Level. Skaters can enter only one (1) level of adult free skating event. In addition, a skater can also enter the Pairs Free Skating event, the Improvisation event, the Interpretation event, the Solo dance event, the Pairs Dance event and the Free Dance event . In the Solo dance event skaters can sign up in maximum two different levels  
However not more than one level higher than tests passed.

The organizers invite the participation of ex-elite skaters. A special category called "Elite Masters" will be added to the competition for these skaters.

Masters Elite Free Skating according to the rules for Masters Free Skating ( [please see required jump elements list](#) )

Masters Elite Pair Skating according to the rules for Masters Pair Skating.

Masters Elite Ice Dancing according to the rules for Gold Dance.

All other skaters of an ISU Member Federation who meet the age requirements may participate.

A skater competing after July 1, 2008 in an ISU Championship or National Championships Of a Member Federation ( other than an Adult Nationals Championships ) or a competition from which a skater qualifies for the National Championships of a Member Federation ( other Than an Adult National Championship ) may NOT participate in this competition. Coaches Are authorized to participate.

All other members of an ISU Member Federation who are not younger than 17 years of age on March 1<sup>st</sup> 2010 may participate.

## I.3 AGE CATEGORIES

The following age categories apply to all Interpretive events and all Free Skating events except Pre-bronze category.

Young Adult	17 yrs - 27 yrs
Class I	28 yrs - 36 yrs
Class II	37 yrs - 46 yrs
Class III	47 yrs - 56 yrs
Class IV	57 yrs+ over

Improvisation and Solo dance events will be grouped by level.  
Based on the number of entries, some classes may be combined.

Pair Skating and Pair Ice Dance Age Categories:

Young Adult : 17-27 years

Adult : 28+

Solo Dance events will be grouped by level.

All age categories may be combined or divided depending on the number of registrations. Proof of age is required for all events. Copy of birth certificate, passport or similar proof of age is acceptable. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to require additional documentation.

## I.4 JUDGING

The new ISU judging system will be used for most categories.

## II. COMPOSITION OF EVENTS

### II.1 SOLO COMPULSORY DANCE

Open to ice dancers of either gender.

The skater is allowed to take part in maximum two categories and only one level higher than tests passed.

<b>PRE-SILVER</b>	Initial Round: Tango ( 2 sequences ) Final Round: Fourteen Step ( 4 sequences )
<b>BRONZE</b>	Initial Round: European Waltz ( 2 sequences ) Final Round: Fourteen Step ( 4 sequences )
<b>PRE-BRONZE</b>	Initial Round: Willow Waltz ( 3 sequences ) Final Round: Fiesta Tango ( 3 sequences )

### II.2 SOLO ORIGINAL DANCE

Requirements: 2 minutes +/- 10 seconds

Original Dance: RHYTHMS and DANCES of the 1920's, 1930's or 1940's. Refer to ISU Communication 1496 for details.

Vocal music allowed, but must skate predominately to the beat not the melody.

Any changes to the Original Dance and Free Dance requirements will be set forth in the competition announcement .

### **BRONZE**

**SPIN:** Only one (1) spin

Minimum 3 revolutions on one foot after which may change feet for further revolutions.

**STEP SEQUENCES:** Only one (1) straight line or diagonal – full ice length.

Variety of continuous turns and steps (no jumps, spins, or stops).

Must include at least 1 twizzle – minimum 1 full revolution.

twizzle. Circular either clockwise or anticlockwise.

**STOPS:** Two (2) 5-second stops are allowed to express the character of the music, one of which may be at the beginning of the program.

## **SILVER AND GOLD**

**SPIN:** Only one (1) spin

Minimum 3 revolutions on one foot after which may change feet for further revolutions.

### **STEP SEQUENCES:**

Two (2) using a variety of continuous steps and turns. No jumps, stops or spins allowed. Full ice coverage on both.

1 midline including a series of twizzles with no more than 3 steps between the twizzles and at least one (1) full revolution on each twizzle.

1 circular either clockwise or anticlockwise.

**STOPS:** Two (2) 5-second stops are allowed to express the character of the music, one of which may be at the beginning of the program.

### **II.3 SOLO FREEDANCE PROGRAM**

Open to ice dancers of either gender.

There will be two distinct age categories:

Young adult : 17 – 27 years

Adult: 28 years and over

The 6.0 judging system will be use.

Test Requirements:

Skaters can enroll in the appropriate category corresponding to their last Ice Dance test

## **GOLD SOLO FREE DANCE**

Duration: 2 min 10 seconds maximum (no penalty for shorter programmes)

Requirements: The Free Dance must contain one but no more than two spins (min 3 revs on one foot) and must contain one step sequence of any type.

## **SILVER SOLO FREE DANCE**

Duration: 1 min 40 seconds maximum (no penalty for shorter programmes)

Requirements: The Free Dance must contain one but no more than two spins (min 3 revs on one foot) and must contain one step sequence of any type.

## **BRONZE SOLO FREE DANCE**

Duration: 1 min 40 seconds maximum (no penalty for shorter programmes)

Requirements: The Free Dance must contain one but no more than two spins (min 3 revs on one foot) and must contain one step sequence of any type.

## **PRE-BRONZE SOLO FREE DANCE**

Duration: 1 min 40 seconds maximum (no penalty for shorter programmes)

Requirements: The Free Dance must contain one but no more than two spins (min 3 revs on one foot) and must contain one step sequence of any type.

## **II.4 PAIRS COMPULSORY DANCE**

There will be two distinct age categories:

Young adult : 17 – 27 years

Adult: 28 years and over

The Referee will indicate the starting point of each dance.

## **II.5 PAIRS ORIGINAL DANCE**

In accordance with Rule 610, ISU Communication 1496 and 1522 and all other pertinent ISU Communications.

The rhythm for the original dance is :

### **Rhythms and Dances of the 1920's, 1930's or 1940's**

Any one or two rhythms/dances originated in the 1920's or 1930's or 1940's may be chosen (except Tango). If two rhythms are used one of them may be repeated. The program should reflect the original flavor and style of the decades mentioned above and NOT performed as a Ballroom Dance.

For general information concerning the rhythms (dances) which belong to the above mentioned decades please refer to the "Ice Dance Music Rhythms Booklet and Compact Disc 1995".

Vocal music is permitted.

Variations of tempo within one selection of music are permitted. If only one rhythm /dance is chosen two different tunes of this rhythm may be used and which may differ in tempo.

Original orchestration of the music of the 1920's, 1930's or 1940's is not required. However, the orchestration must be in the style of the decade chosen.

If appropriate for the chosen music the lady and the man are permitted to wear trousers and sleeves of any length. Rule 612 should apply. Props that are part of the costume and are characteristic for the chosen music are allowed (hats, head bands, ribbon). Props may not be thrown in any part of the program.

Note: The Referee will make a proper costume deduction for a prop which is detached.

The couple should announce in their "Planned Program Content" submission the Rhythm(s)/dance(s) and the decade(s) of the music chosen for the Original Dance.

Required elements:

- Two (2) different types of dance lifts, with a maximum of 6 seconds duration each;
- One (1) Diagonal or Midline Step Sequence in varied hold;
- One (1) Dance spin, with optional position, minimum of two (3) revolutions by each partner on one foot. A Combination Spin is NOT permitted. The number of rotations and different positions are described in ISU Communication 1522.

Duration: 2 minutes and 40 seconds but may be less.

#### IV.1 ENTRY FEES

- 50 Euros for first singles event
- 25 Euros for second singles event
- 20 Euros for the third singles event
- 10 Euros for the fourth singles event
- 30 Euros for each partner of pair or dance team

All entries must be sent to the attention of the Registrar and must be either postmarked and mailed to Streda Doleda, 8 38032 Canazei TN - **Italy** by March 1st, 2010. In general, late entries will not be accepted. However under unusual conditions, late entries may only be accepted at the discretion of the Organizing Committee and will carry a 20 Euro late entry fee.

If you withdraw from the competition and if we are notified before March 20, 2010.

Refund Policy : The Organizing Committee will refund entrance fees less a 30 Euro processing charge. Full refunds will be given if we are notified before the close of entries, March 1st, 2010. No refunds will be given after March 20th, 2010, unless :

- The event is not held, and the skater does not wish to skate an exhibition. OR
- There is a death in the competitor's immediate family within a week of the competition
- The competitor has an injury or illness, therefore the competitor will need to send a letter signed by his/her physician showing inability to compete. If this is done one month prior the competition date, the participant will be fully refunded, two weeks prior the competition 50 percent refund, one week prior the competition 25 percent refund.

A 20 Euro charge will be made for all checks returned by the bank for any reason and payment must be made by cash, or transfer by bank.

Currency : Payment of fees must be in Euros. For those coming from outside the European community, please send payment in the form of a Bank money transfer. **Please take note to use the International Bank Account Number (IBAN) .**

#### **IV.2 REGISTRATION**

The official Registration Desk will be open throughout the competition. Competitors must register promptly upon arrival.

#### **IV.3 AWARDS**

Awards will be presented to the 1st, 2nd, 3rd place winners in each event. Skaters should receive their awards in their competition outfit.

## V. SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION

### V.1 ADMISSIONS

This event will be open to the public. There will be no fees charged.

### V.2 MUSIC

Only cassette tapes (no cases, please) or CDs ( standard compact disc format only ) will be accepted.

**BE CAREFUL NO MINI DISCS ACCEPTED!!** Cassettes and CDs must be clearly marked with name, event entered, length of music and side to be played. Each disc or cassette must have only ONE track on it. Any disc with more than one track will not be accepted! Lead in time ( time before the music begins may not exceed 3 seconds. Cassettes or CDs which are not properly identified will NOT be accepted. **Competition music must be turned in at registration** and will be available for pick up at the Registration Desk at the conclusion of the event. Tapes will not be mailed back to competitors. All competitors must have an additional duplicated cassette with them in the rink. The Organizers will accept no responsibility for damage to cassettes or loss of cassettes, but will take every precaution to ensure their safety. The Organizers will supply current dance music for compulsory dances.

### V.3 PLANNED PROGRAM

When submitting music each skater, pair, or couple also shall submit their planned program content, including the elements, with an appropriate time code, for each event of the competition.

### V.4 VIDEO TAPING

Those interested in videotaping must obtain permission upon arrival at the competition. It will be restricted to one area. Except for the official Videographers, only battery operated cameras will be permitted.

### V.5 MEDICAL

Qualified medical personnel will be on site from the start of official practices until the end of the event.
